Overnight Flight from JFK

Day 1: Travel day

Board your overnight flight to Madrid, Spain

Day 2: Arrival

Included meals: Welcome dinner

Welcome to Spain! Meet your tour director, who will escort you and the group to take the bullet train to the south of Spain.

Once we have arrived in Sevilla, we will transfer to the hotel in the historic center.

Day 3: Seville

Day 4: Seville/Granada

After lunch, we will enjoy some free time; head back to the hotel and rest for an evening of flamenco, local cuisine and the most spectacular view of the Alhambra Palace you will even witness. If we play our cards right, there may even be some local musicians playing flamenco music.



Day 5: Granada

This evening we will have dinner en la Calle Navas, one of Granada's popular streets that are lined with a plethora of local restaurants. After dinner, whoever is interested, can accompany your tour director for an evening stroll and eventually to sit at the foot of Granada's beautiful cathedral.

Day 6: Granada/Murcia
